Since 1915, Troop 2 has provided a challenging program for Beverly area boys. Boy Scouting is an action oriented program designed to take place outdoors.

The hallmark of Troop 2 is its outdoor program. An outdoor activity, typically a campout, is planned every month of the year.

The campouts give meaning and use to skills the scouts develop as they advance in rank and learn skills to earn merit badges. Our campouts are in the woods - usually at local sites and not out of cars. They involve hiking in the site, carrying your gear / food / water and campfire cooking by patrol. These activities build self-reliance and self-confidence along with outdoor skills and know-how.

Boy Scouts is the only youth organization we know of where it's largely run by the boys to enable them to gain responsibility and leadership experience while having fun.

Troop Meetings are on Friday evenings from 6:45 - 9:00 during the school year, and Tuesdays evenings from 6:45 - 9:00 during the summer, in the downstairs hall of the Dane Street Church. Access the hall by using the entrance in the rear of the church by the parking lot. Go down the stairs.
